WILDWOOD CREEK BASIN PROJECT

The City of Yucaipa will be holding a community meeting to solicit input on the Wildwood Creek Basin Project.

The Wildwood Creek Basin Project is a multi-purpose project providing for improved flood control along Wildwood Creek, passive recreation including trails and landscaped areas, and creating an opportunity for groundwater recharge. The project is proposed for an approximate 25 acre site generally located southerly of Wildwood Canyon Road and easterly of Holmes Street.

The project is a joint effort among the City, the San Bernardino County Flood Control District and the Federal Emergency Management Agency to reduce flooding in the Yucaipa Community.

The City Council approved a preliminary concept plan for the project in September 2004 and recently approved a final concept plan on November 10, 2008. A copy of the final concept plan is included for your information. Final design of the project is now underway by the City's consultant, Albert A. Webb Associates of Riverside.

Community involvement in the process of implementing the City's capital improvements is very important to the ultimate success. We look forward to seeing you there.
