



## City of Yucaipa Public Works Department Construction Update

The following is an update of construction projects in the City  
April 2008

### **7<sup>th</sup> Street Park Rehabilitation – Phase I**

This project includes meandering walkways, improved planting areas along the park perimeter (slopes & parkways), installation of a prefabricated restroom facility, removal of existing restroom facility, walkway lighting, new/improved picnic areas. The restroom and walkway is complete and the remaining construction is underway and now scheduled to be completed by **May 2008**.

### **7<sup>th</sup> Street Park Rehabilitation – Phase II**

The project consists of retrofitting a partially finished concrete pad as three covered basketball courts with lighting. In addition, the project will include retrofitting several gazebos with additional landscaping around the “formal” main gazebo to enhance its use for special events. ADA accessibility will also be enhanced by completing improvements to the north parking lot, sidewalks and the existing kids club/theater building at the park. This project is now scheduled to begin this month and completed by **November 2008**.

### **Traffic Signal Modification at Yucaipa Boulevard and 4<sup>th</sup> Street**

This project consisted of traffic signal installation, curb & gutter, crosswalks, and sidewalks. This project has been completed.

### **Yucaipa Boulevard South Side Widening- 7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> Street**

This project consists of widening Yucaipa Boulevard along the South Side between 7<sup>th</sup> Street and 10<sup>th</sup> Street, including pavement, curb, gutter, sidewalk and bike lanes on both sides of the street. It will also include repair of affected landscaping, sign and fence relocation, and installation of driveways at specific locations. This project is underway and now scheduled to be completed **this month**.

### **Oak Glen Creek (Wilson II) Basins Project:**

This project includes Flood Control/Groundwater Recharge Basins, passive recreational trails, rest areas, landscaping and irrigation, habitat set-a-side areas, limited parking and an educational signage program. This Project is scheduled to begin mid April and be completed by **December of this year**.

**West Parking Lot-Senior Center:** This project consists of the replacing the existing parking lot and constructing a new trash enclosure. This project is underway and will be completed by **July of this year**.

### **Yucaipa Boulevard – South Side Widening – 5<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Street**

This project will widen Yucaipa Boulevard on the South side to three full lanes including, pavement, curb, gutter, sidewalk, and bike lanes on both sides of the street. It will also include repair of affected landscaping, sign and fence relocation, and installation of driveways at specific locations. This project is underway and now scheduled to be completed by **May 2008**.

### **Live Oak/Oak Glen Interchange**

This is a joint project between the City and SANBAG with the construction being administered by SANBAG. This project consists of widening all on and off ramps to the I-10 Freeway, reconstructing the bridge over the Freeway (5 lanes) and installing interconnected traffic signals at all ramps. The project is underway and scheduled to be completed within **12 to 18 months**.

### **Oak Glen Interconnect Project**

This project includes the installation of the conduit, cabling, and appurtenances necessary to interconnect all present and future traffic signals along Oak Glen Road between the I-10 Freeway and Bryant Street. This project has been completed except for some cleanup items.

### **Center Park Rehabilitation**

This project includes demolition of the parking lot, sidewalks repairs, meandering walkways, improved planting areas along the park perimeter (slopes & parkways), covered picnic tables, installation of a new half court basketball facility, walkway lighting, security camera, and new playground equipment. This project is underway and is now expected to be completed **this month**.
