



Public Works Department Construction Update March 2010

Public Works Construction Projects in the City of Yucaipa

Yucaipa Blvd Improvements, 12th Street to 15th Street – Phase II

This project will widen Yucaipa Boulevard to three lanes in each direction between 12th Street and 14th Street. The project includes asphalt pavement, curb, gutter, sidewalk, and bike lane striping. It will also include necessary landscape improvements, sign and fence relocation, minor utility relocations and installation of driveway approaches at specific locations. This project will start this month and is scheduled to be **completed in August 2010**.

Oak Glen Road Improvements, 5th Street to Bryant Street

This project, funded in part by Federal Safe Route to School Grant funding, will install sidewalk along the north side of Oak Glen Road between Stonewood Drive and Bryant Street. The project will also include the installation of a new traffic signal at Oak Glen Road and Sunnyside Drive and will modify the existing traffic signal at Stonewood Drive and Oak Glen Road to accommodate a north-south crosswalk along the eastern leg of the intersection providing connectivity to the new sidewalk and existing trail system on the north side of Oak Glen Road. This project also includes bike lane striping along Oak Glen Road from 5th Street to Sunnyside Drive and street widening, pavement rehab, curb & gutter and minor drainage improvements between Stonewood Drive to Sunnyside Drive (both sides) and Sunnyside Drive to Bryant Street (north side). This project is underway and is scheduled to be **completed in July 2010**.

Wildwood Park Renovation

This project consists of new curbing, a new bridge, a new dog park, equestrian area parking improvements, irrigation modifications, new drinking fountains, trail improvements and new fencing throughout the park. This project is underway and is scheduled to be **completed in April 2010**.

Yucaipa Transit Center

The project will include eight bus bays as part of the ‘bus plaza’, each with a sheltered bench. The interior spine of the plaza will have a combination of bus bench shelters, landscaping and a meandering “streambed” connecting a water feature on the north with a clock feature on the south. New concrete will be installed for the bus access along with new curb and gutter and sidewalks to tie the project into the City Hall and the Library and Sheriff Department Buildings. Construction is underway and will be **completed in April 2010**.

3rd Street Improvements, Yucaipa Blvd. to Avenue E

This project consists of installing curb, gutter, sidewalk, driveway approaches, ADA curb ramps, miscellaneous parkway improvements and pavement rehabilitation. This project is underway and is scheduled to be **completed in April 2010**.

2009-2010 Street Rehabilitation Program

This project consists of several different processes; pulverize and overlay, grind and overlay and edge mill and overlay on various streets throughout the City. This project is scheduled to be **completed this month**.

2009-2010 Street Striping Program

This project consists of restriping of existing city streets throughout the community. This project is underway and is scheduled to be **completed this month**.

1st Street Improvements, Yucaipa Blvd to Avenue E

This project consists of installing curb, gutter, sidewalk, driveway approaches, ADA curb ramps, parking improvements and miscellaneous parkway improvements. This project is underway and is scheduled to be **completed this month**.

Oak Glen Creek (Wilson II) Basins Project

This is a joint project among San Bernardino County Flood Control District, Yucaipa Valley Water District, and the Inland Empire Resource Conservation District with the design and construction being administered by the City of Yucaipa. This project includes flood control/groundwater recharge basins, passive recreational trails, rest areas, landscaping and irrigation, habitat set-a-side areas, limited parking and an educational signage program. When completed this project will reduce flooding downstream through the community, particularly in the Dunlap area. Except for some final clean-up items, **this project has been completed.**

Yucaipa Boulevard Improvements, South Side, 6th Street to 7th Street and 10th Street to 12th Street

This project will complete the widening of Yucaipa Blvd between 5th Street and 12th Street to three lanes in each direction including pavement, curb, gutter, sidewalk, and bike lanes on both sides of the street. It will also include repair of affected landscaping, sign and fence relocation, and installation of driveways at specific locations. Except for some final clean-up items, **this project has been completed.**

Yucaipa Boulevard Improvements, 12th Street to 15th Street – Phase I

The project will provide storm drain improvements along Yucaipa Boulevard between 13th Street and 14th Street. This is Phase I of street and drainage improvements along Yucaipa Boulevard from 12th Street to 15th Street. Except for some final clean-up items, **this Phase has been completed.**

Storm Drain Replacement at Three Locations– Douglas Street Between Avenue D & Avenue E – Fremont Street at Avenue D, Fremont Street at Ramada Lane

This project consists of replacement of storm drain culverts with larger culverts at Douglas Street between Avenue D & Avenue E and between Fremont Street and Ramada Lane, and headwall reconstruction at Fremont and Avenue D. **This project has been completed.**

January Storm Damage Mitigation Projects – Douglas Street South of Avenue E

This project consists of replacement of an existing storm drain and upsizing with new storm drain, headwalls and outlet structures. This project is scheduled to be underway this month and **completed in April.**

Wildwood Creek Slope Repair – Adjacent to Wildwood Park

This project consists of replacement of embankment repair within Wildwood Creek eroding into the park embankment caused by the January storms. This project is underway and scheduled to be **completed this month.**

Emergency Repair Work at Calimesa Blvd (2 locations)

This project consists of slope erosions repairs next to Calimesa Blvd. Caused by the January Storms. This project is scheduled to start and be **completed this month.**

Grandview Basin Slope Repair at Grandview Drive

This project consists of slope repair to the Grandview Basin caused by the January storms. This project is scheduled to start and be **completed this month.**
