

**RESOLUTION NO. 2009-52**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUCAIPA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2009-07, ESTABLISHING THE YOUTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF THE CITY OF YUCAIPA.**

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2009 the City Council of the City of Yucaipa adopted Resolution No. 2009-07, establishing the Youth Advisory Committee of the City of Yucaipa; and

WHEREAS, the appointed Councilmember liaisons to the Youth Advisory Committee sought additional input from community members in the makeup and direction of the Committee and several meetings were held with selected community members and,

WHEREAS, amendments to Resolution No. 2009-07 were recommended based on that input.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUCAIPA, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1:** Section 1 of Resolution No. 2009-07 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That a Youth Advisory Committee consisting of ten members is hereby established.


**Section 2:** Section 2 of Resolution No. 2009-07 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That membership on the Youth Advisory Committee shall occur through appointment by the Mayor and Council with the benefit of recommendations made through the Councilmember liaisons. At the time of his or her appointment, and during his or her tenure of office, each committee member shall reside or attend school within the City of Yucaipa, and shall be between the ages of 15 and 25. The terms of each appointee shall be approximately one year, expiring on the September 30, occurring approximately one year after his or her appointment.

**Section 6:** Section 6 of Resolution No. 2009-07 is hereby amended to read as follows:


Section 6. Two City Councilmembers will be appointed to serve as non-voting liaisons to the Youth Advisory Committee.

## EXHIBIT A

### Role of the Youth Advisory Committee

#### 1. Powers, duties, and responsibilities.

The Yucaipa Youth Advisory Committee shall be empowered to establish and maintain written policy and rules and have the following general powers, duties and responsibilities consistent with the City of Yucaipa, Municipal Code and all other ordinances and regulations of the City of Yucaipa and with the laws of the State of California:

- a. Promote community involvement and public service, with, for, and by youth.
- b. Review and/or suggest proposals for programs, projects and facilities as they pertain to youth.
- c. Assist in the initiating, development, evaluation and planning for arts, recreation and social service programs with an emphasis on youth.
- d. Review and make recommendations on matters pertaining to youth programming and/or services to the Parks and Recreation Commission and/or City Council.
- e. Promote youth involvement in community events, programs or volunteer projects through public education, the schools and community organizations.
- f. Act in an advisory capacity to the City Council in all other policy matters pertaining to youth.

#### 2. Eligibility for the Youth Advisory Committee.

The following criteria will be considered for eligibility as a member of the Yucaipa Youth Advisory Committee:

- a. Applicants must be residents of, or attending school in the City of Yucaipa.
- b. The Yucaipa Youth Advisory Committee shall consist of ten members, appointed by the Mayor and Council. The term of office for Committee members shall be one year, typically beginning on October 1 and ending September 30, one year hence with the possibility of a one year extension.
- c. Membership is open to all youth meeting the above criteria.
- d. Members of the Yucaipa Youth Advisory Committee shall not hold any paid office or employment with the City of Yucaipa.
- e. Failure of a regular member to attend three consecutive regular meetings of the Youth Advisory Committee without the consent of the Youth Advisory Committee shall be deemed to constitute the retirement of such member and the position declared vacant.
