

RESOLUTION NO. 97-32

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUCAIPA,
CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 91-10, ADOPTING RULES
OF PROCEDURE FOR PLANNING COMMISSION MEETINGS AND RELATED
FUNCTIONS AND ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS, the purpose and intent of the City Council in adopting Rules of Procedure is to provide directory guidelines relating to the conduct of public business by or on behalf of the Planning Commission, and in the event of any non-compliance with or violation of any provision herein, such will not be deemed to affect the validity of any action taken, unless otherwise specifically provided by law, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has designated the Planning Commission as the Board of Appeal for the abatement of public nuisances, and, therefore, the Rules of Procedure for the Planning Commission need to be amended to include this designation.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUCAIPA, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 4.3 DUTIES

1. The Planning Commission shall act as the Planning Agency for all land-use applications which require public hearings and for those which are referred or appealed to the Commission.

2. The Planning Commission shall act as the Board of Appeal for the abatement of public nuisances.
