Assist in preparing required materials and supplies for scheduled activities. Supervise up to 15 children in a group setting. Help maintain a clean and orderly site, monitor and maintain all supplies and equipment. Establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers and the public. Maintain a professional attitude and appearance. Ability to deal with sensitive situations in an appropriate manner, communicate in a positive manner with participants, parents and staff. Assist in necessary paperwork for the daily administration of the program.

Applicant must be 18 years of age or older, be willing to learn and take direction, have good communication skills and a genuine interest in children. Successful applicants must possess a valid California driver's license, obtain First Aid and CPR certifications and successfully have fingerprints and drug tests taken prior to employment.
