

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING IN CONNECTION WITH THE  
CITY OF YUCAIPA REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICE CHARGES**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of Yucaipa (“City”) proposes to increase refuse collection service charges, effective July 1, 2023. In compliance with Proposition 218, Article XIID, of the California State Constitution, and the Proposition 218 Omnibus Implementation Act, the City hereby notifies all affected property owners and occupants of the proposed charges for refuse collection services. The Yucaipa City Council will consider the refuse collection service charges at a Public Hearing on Monday, June 12, 2023, at 6:00 PM in the City Council Chambers of City Hall, located at 34272 Yucaipa Blvd, Yucaipa, California, 92399. All interested persons are invited to participate in the Public Hearing.

If the City Council adopts the charges at the Public Hearing on June 12, 2023, the rates will be effective and will take effect July 1, 2023. For more information please call 909-797-2489 or visit [www.yucaipa.org](http://www.yucaipa.org).

**PROPOSED INCREASE TO RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL REFUSE COLLECTION  
SERVICE CHARGES**

The City’s refuse collection services provider, Yucaipa Disposal Inc, is requesting an increase in the charges for refuse collection services pursuant to City Council adopted rate-setting procedures, that are detailed in Section 17(C) of the Franchise Agreement. If approved, the proposed increases in the charges will become effective on July 1, 2023.

**SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS ARE CHARGED ON THE TAX ROLL UNLESS  
THE PROPERTY OWNER PRE-PAYS BY JULY 11, 2023**

On March 11, 2019, the City Council of the City of Yucaipa adopted Ordinance No. 373 which authorizes County Tax Roll billing for single-family residential refuse collection service customers. The charges for single-family residential refuse collection service customers are collected on the County Tax Roll in the same manner, by the same persons, and at the same time as together with and not separately from the general taxes of the City, and all laws applicable to the levy, collection, and enforcement of general taxes of the City, including, but not limited to, those pertaining to the matters of delinquency, correction, cancellation, refund and redemptions, shall be applicable to the charges.

Single-family residential service customers have the option to pre-pay for Fiscal Year 2023/2024 services to avoid having the charges placed on their property tax bill. The pre-payment option must be received by Yucaipa Disposal, Inc. on or before July 11, 2023.

**WRITTEN REPORT FOR LEVY OF CHARGES FOR SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL SERVICE  
CUSTOMERS ON THE COUNTY TAX ROLL**

The City has caused a written report to be prepared and filed with the City Clerk regarding the proposed increased residential and commercial refuse collection service charges along with a written report that provides data indicating the amount of cost, or estimated cost, to provide refuse collection service and the revenue sources anticipated to provide the service. A copy of the written report will be available on the city’s website at [www.yucaipa.org](http://www.yucaipa.org) and at City Hall by June 1, 2023.

## **PUBLIC HEARING**

At the Public Hearing, the City Council will hear and consider all testimony concerning the new proposed refuse collection service charges. If you oppose the proposed charges, your protest must be submitted in writing to be considered.

Written protests must be submitted to the City Clerk's office by 2:00 pm on Monday, June 12, 2023. Written Protests may also be delivered during the Public Hearing at the location, date, and time noted above. All written protests must contain a statement indicating your opposition to the proposed charges or collection method, the Assessor Parcel Number (APN), the service address, and the signature of the property owner(s)/occupant(s). Owners of multiple properties must file a separate written protest for each property. Only one written protest per parcel will be accepted. Protests sent by email or fax will not be accepted, nor protests received after the Public Hearing is closed. Public comments at the Hearing will not qualify as a formal protest unless accompanied by a written protest.
