SUBJECT: “Color Me Miles” Youth Advisory Committee Color Run

RECOMMENDATION:

That City Council:

1. Approve the Special Event Permit Application submitted by the Youth Advisory Committee to conduct “Color Me Miles,” a Color Run at Yucaipa Community Park and Bryant Glen Sports Complex trails on Saturday, April 22, 2017; and
2. Waive the \$15 Special Event Application fee.

DISCUSSION:

The Youth Advisory Committee (YAC) is comprised of 10 young adults and serves as an advisory body to the City Council. The purpose of the YAC is to improve youth involvement in City issues and activities and provide committee members a roadmap for success. Each year YAC supports and/or endorses a community project. This year the YAC has decided to put on a community color run (Run) event. The goal of the event is to bring family, friends and the community together for a kaleidoscope of fun.

The objective of the Run is to shower participants with color. The Run will be approximately three miles around the Community Park and Bryant Glen trails with six color stations. The color is biodegradable with FDA approved dyes; it is safe and easy to clean up. On race day, participants will receive a white t-shirt, sunglasses, a color packet and snacks.

The YAC has submitted a Special Event Permit Application requesting the use of Yucaipa Community Park and Bryant Glen trails for the “Color Me Miles” Run. The requested use of City property is planned for Saturday, April 22, 2017 from 5:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The applicant is anticipating between 100 and 200 participants. Entry fees include:

- Individual Pre-Registration \$20
- Individual Day of Registration \$25

The Run will start and finish at the Yucaipa Community Park Amphitheater. To conduct the Run, the applicant is requesting the use of the Yucaipa Community Park and Bryant Glen trails. If approval is granted, all organizations that are scheduled to utilize Yucaipa Community Park and Bryant Glen will be notified.
