SUBJECT: Award of Contract and Reject Bids- Utility Installations at BMX Facility, 13th Street Sports Complex & Fire Station Facility- Project No. 11002

RECOMMENDATION:

That City Council:

1. Award and authorize the Mayor to execute a contract in the amount of \$28,800, with Torga Electrical, Inc. of San Bernardino, CA for the Utility Installations at 13th Street Sports Complex (Bid Schedule B); and
2. Approve the amount of \$2,880 for contingencies for the Project and the amount of \$2,535 for construction administration, inspection and surveying, for a total construction budget in the amount of \$34,215; and
3. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to administer the terms of the contract; and
4. Approve the Plans and Specifications prepared for the Project; and
5. Reject all bids for the Sewer Lateral Installation to the BMX Facility (Bid Schedule A); and
6. Reject all bids for the Sewer Lateral Installation to Fire Station No. 2 (Bid Schedule C).

BACK GROUND:

City Council approved an agreement with Yucaipa Valley National Little League (YVNLL) for use of the 13th Street Sports Complex on March 26, 2012 which prescribed that the City construct several improvements at the facility including a restroom/concession stand, electrical service conduit, hardscape improvements, fencing and backstops. The agreement indicates that YVNLL is to construct the parking lot, walls and the landscaping/irrigation for the play fields. The majority of the improvements for which the City is responsible for have been completed and the **YVNLL has purchased the sod while members of the Church of Latter Day Saints and other community members volunteered to install the sod on one of the four fields as part of the Just Serve-Day of Community Service event.** The remaining items to be completed by the City include the installation of the irrigation controller for the facility, final electrical and sewer service connections to the facility (including connection to the concession and restroom building), trash enclosure construction, interior and exterior slope irrigation and landscaping, monument sign installation and additional concrete work. The proposed contract includes several of these items. The total estimated cost for these remaining items is in the amount of \$255,000. Staff will continue to work with
