



**City of Yucaipa  
Notice to Voters of Date After Which  
No Arguments For or Against a City Measure  
May be Submitted to the City Clerk**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Special Municipal election is to be held in the City of Yucaipa on March 3, 2020, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following measure:

“To avoid cutbacks in Yucaipa’s existing paramedic program and increased response times on emergency 911 calls; generate funds from Yucaipa visitors to benefit local residents; enhance police and fire protection; increase local youth and senior services; and fund other general services provided throughout the City like streets and parks, shall the ordinance be adopted to increase the local sales tax by one-half percent; generating approximately \$2,000,000 annually, with citizen oversight, mandatory audits, and public reporting?”

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the legislative body of the City, or any member or members thereof authorized by the body, or any individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations, may file a written argument, not to exceed 300 words in length, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, for or against the City measure.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, based upon the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and Voter Information Guide for the election, the City Clerk has fixed **5:00 PM, December 12, 2019**, as the date after which no arguments for or against the City measure(s) may be submitted to the clerk for printing and distribution to the voters as provided in the Article 4. Arguments shall be submitted to the City Clerk, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, at the City Hall, Yucaipa, California. Arguments may be changed or withdrawn until and including the date fixed by the City Clerk.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that if direct arguments are filed, rebuttal arguments not to exceed 250 words in length, may be submitted by the authors of the opposing direct arguments and filed with the Clerk, accompanied by the printed names(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, not more than 10 days after the final date for filing direct arguments.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that any proposed ordinance, ballot question, impartial analysis, or direct argument filed under the authority of the elections code will be available for public examination in the clerk's office for 10-calendar days following the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analysis(es).
