OBSERVATIONS:

From Last Inspection- Discarded scrap metal remains on the ranch that still needs to be removed. No rooster was seen on the ranch on this inspection. Cement entryways that had spilled fluid appeared to have been cleaned.

In this inspection – There was deceased chickens laying openly at the entryways of the coops that were not properly disposed of. Some coops had sinks with sitting water accumulating flies.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Remove discarded scrap metal, debris, and other miscellaneous inoperable equipment from ranch. Continue to keep areas outside of the chicken houses as clean as possible from manure and large quantities of accumulation of feathers. Continue to remove the miscellaneous spilled fluids from the coops. Dispose of deceased chickens in air-tight containers. As much as possible avoid leaving open sitting water that will attract flies.
