**OBSERVATIONS:**

Before entering the ranch a notable amount of flies were noticed and a more substantial amount were present inside the coops.  
 There were multiple leaks throughout the coops causing large puddles and excessive wet/damp manure. The wet areas were being treated with Triazicide granules, however there were some larvae present mostly toward the end of the coops.  
 Dead birds that had been collected were left un-covered at the entry of the coops, there were also two full bins of dead poultry that were left uncovered.  
 There were some areas where feed had been spilled, not excessive but noted.  
 Broken eggs and feathers needed to be cleared out.  
 It appeared that there was some manure left behind from the previous days pick up (it all needs to make it into the manure truck).

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Continue the Manure Management Plan, remove all manure and provide manure haul slips.  
 Repair or replace damaged and broken water lines and water cups.  
 Continue to treat wet manure areas with larvacide, additionally, apply an adulticide (spray) to areas where adult flies are gathering.  
 When dead birds are located immediately remove and place them in a covered container or bin.  
 Remove all broken eggs and feathers daily.  
 Remove all excessive vegetation.

**ACTION TAKEN:**

This ranch is out of compliance, a citation has been issued in the amount of \$500. Re-inspections will be on going and further fines may be imposed if these conditions continue.
