OBSERVATIONS:

I observed an increase in flies inside the ranch, potentially due to the manure pile located adjacent to the coops. The fly strips were full and should be replaced. I viewed approximately 3 dead chickens and broken eggs not stored in sealed containers that needed to be properly disposed of. The ranch had an abundance of feathers inside and along the exterior of the coops. Several rodent traps observed throughout the coops, all were clear. I observed the small pile of sheet metal remains and should be cleared from the premise. The ranch has an excessive amount of overgrown vegetation along the perimeter.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Dead chickens must be removed every 72 hours. Remove the excessive feathers and building material. I spoke to the owner who advised the manure pile would be removed by tomorrow and I explained the areas along the perimeter of the ranch where the overgrown vegetation needed to be abated.

ACTION TAKEN:

Verbal communication with the owner onsite to identify the areas of concern.
