OBSERVATIONS:

I observed a moderate amount of flies inside the ranch. The fly strips were full and should be replaced immediately. The manure pile has been removed, and I did not observe any dead chickens or broken eggs. The ranch has an abundance of feathers inside and along the exterior of the coops; I spoke with the manager who advised he would have employees start to remove the excessive feathers. Several rodent traps observed throughout the coops, all were clear. I observed the small pile of sheet metal and should be cleared from the property. The overgrown vegetation along the perimeter of the property has been cleared.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Replace fly strips when full. Remove the excessive feathers and building material before next inspection. Spoke to the manager and showed him the concern with the excessive feathers in and around the coops.

ACTION TAKEN:

Verbal communication with the manager onsite to identify the areas of concern.
