OBSERVATIONS:

While suiting up and walking through the ranch no flies were observed, when inside the coops the flies were minimal. There were broken eggs that needed to be cleaned up (they have had problems with skunks getting to the eggs). There was a small amount of manure under the coop but it was dry and no larvae were present. A pile of manure mixed with many broken eggs was openly stored on the back side of the chicken coops. The water basins looked good and the surrounding dirt area was dry. There was a small area of overgrown vegetation.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The pile of manure/eggs is to be removed immediately and discontinue this action. Since we are experiencing unusually warm weather for this time of year the employees should continue to be preemptive in the maintenance and use pesticide if necessary. Broken eggs are to be collected routinely and stored in an air tight container, continue with the manure management plan. And remove the patch of overgrown vegetation.

Notified the ranch manager that I will be doing unscheduled visits to the ranch to validate compliancy.
