OBSERVATIONS:

No fly population was observed. Several different areas under the coops were inspected and larvae were observed under only one of the coops. Owner was advised to rake around all uprights on east side of coops on a weekly basis to ensure more thorough removal of manure. Minimal broken eggs were noted under coops. Manure will be picked up this evening (Tuesday), Thursday, and Saturday. Fly traps okay. Vegetation has been abated between most of the coops (rest will be done before the end of the week) but needs to be abated down to 4 inches height at all times and maintained.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Maintain removal of chicken manure per the Manure Management Plan requirements including raking around the posts of the coops to allow for more thorough abatement on a weekly basis. Repair all leaks in pipes and cups.

Next inspection scheduled for Tuesday, March 20, 2018.
