OBSERVATIONS:

First on-site inspection done since Newcastle Disease prevented on-site inspections. Owner states that there are only approximately 50 (I observed approximately 20-30) birds on the ranch and they are free range which requires no manure removal. No manure observed in the empty cages previously occupied. Manure was noted in the free range area (stuck in between and on top of the cage-like shelves where the chickens roost). There is a severe issue with the overgrown and dead vegetation and excessive trash and debris in and around the entire property. Minimal flies noted.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Remove the manure stuck in the areas the chickens roost in the free range area. Abate ALL overgrown and dead vegetation from the property as well as begin removing all unnecessary trash and debris (junk) from the property.

ACTION TAKEN:

Will re-inspect on Thursday, June 18, 2020 for compliance. If not in compliance fines will be administered.
