**OBSERVATIONS:**

Second on-site inspection done since Newcastle Disease prevented on-site inspections. Owner states that there are only approximately 50 (I observed approximately 20-25) birds on the ranch and they are free range which requires no manure removal. No manure observed in the empty cages previously occupied. Manure that had been previously stuck in the cage-like shelves has been removed. The vegetation between the cages has been mowed down and remainder will be weed whacked next week. SB County Weed Abatement has notified us that he is not in compliance with regards to the overgrown/dead vegetation and has until June 22, 2020 to complete abatement or they will begin the abatement process. Trash and debris in and around the entire property is slowly being abated. Minimal flies noted.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Continue to abate ALL of the overgrown and dead vegetation from the property and the trash and debris (junk-remove or place in a structure for storage) from the property.

**ACTION TAKEN:**

Will re-inspect on Thursday, July 9, 2020 for compliance. If not in compliance fines will be administered.
