OBSERVATIONS:

Large amount of flies below chicken coops on wet droppings which were accumulating on dry droppings that the owner intends on using as backfill to level out ground below cage rows. Fly traps were full of live flies. Excessive flies were noted on buildings and vehicles. Several parts of dead chickens were discovered on the ground between the buildings as well as many broken eggs.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Immediately repair all leaks (5 large ones were observed). Rake dry chicken droppings over to location of backfill and spray with insecticide immediately. Increase insecticide spraying to 3 times a week and remove broken eggs and all fresh manure from around the cages. Collect all dead chicken carcasses/parts and secure in air-tight containers until pick up.

ACTION TAKEN:

Poultry ranch owner stated that all water leaks will be repaired and complete round of insecticide will be sprayed beneath all chicken cages by end of day.
