### OBSERVATIONS:

Fly population has decreased since last inspection. Still accumulating dry droppings with the intention of using it for backfill to level out area beneath each of the coops. During inspection several spots were checked for larvae where fresh droppings were accumulating on dry droppings. Larvae were present in the samples checked. Owner sprayed twice last week (Tuesday and Saturday). Several chicken parts and broken eggs were also noted but were less than last inspection and were removed during inspection.

### RECOMMENDATIONS:

Remove chicken manure per the Manure Management Plan requirements. As discussed remove dried manure down 2 inches and replace with soil to encourage biological insects that aid in abating larvae and to bring grade up for easy removal of fresh manure. Continue with the spraying 2 times a week. Continue to abate areas between coops of feathers, eggs, and vegetation.

### ACTION TAKEN:

Will begin the removal process of the manure and installation of at least 2 inches of dirt. Fix all leaks (ongoing issue).
