There were no piles of manure but it will be collected today (Tuesday) and removed tonight. Fly traps were rejuvenated Thursday of last week as noted in the logs. There were a few leaks noted in one of the coops that will be remedied today.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Maintain manure management plan and repair leaks in the one coop.
