Only flies noted were in the fly traps on the east side...minimal fania flies swarming in one area only. Many sites (under coops and large pile) were inspected for evidence of larvae but none were discovered. Fly traps were rejuvenated Tuesday of this week as noted in the log. There were no leaks noted. Just a few broken eggs need to be abated between coops. There were several dead chickens laying around the ranch that were a result of coyotes but were removed immediately for disposal.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Maintain manure management plan and scrape up all manure in collection area.
