OBSERVATIONS:

Fania flies were observed in all coops (moderate) and larger flies were noted in the fly traps on the east side of the coops. Many sites (under coops and large pile) were inspected for evidence of larvae but minimal were discovered. Fly traps were rejuvenated Tuesday (May 22, 2018) of last week and were functioning properly. There were no leaks noted. Broken eggs need to be abated between coops. There were several parts of dead chickens laying around the ranch that were removed immediately for disposal.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Maintain removal of chicken manure per the Manure Management Plan requirements. Spray under coop where larvae were discovered.

Next on-site inspection scheduled for Friday, June 8 , 2018.
