**OBSERVATIONS:**

First on-site inspection done since Newcastle Disease prevented on-site inspections. Ranch is now owned by another party other than Hoover. Owner states that there are only approximately 50 birds on the ranch and they are free range which requires no manure removal. Minimal manure from cages that have been unoccupied since last October is still there and at least 8-10 pools of water from leaking cups were noted below the empty cages. Maggots were noted only in one of the areas. There is overgrown and dead vegetation in and around the entire property. Minimal flies noted.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Immediately turn off water or repair/replace malfunctioning or broken cups to all unoccupied or empty cages. Remove ALL manure from under the empty cages and dispose of properly (arrange for a pick up-no stockpiling). Abate ALL of the overgrown and vegetation from the property including in the empty chicken houses.

**ACTION TAKEN:**

Will re-inspect on Monday, June 15, 2020 for compliance. If not in compliance fines will be administrered.
