OBSERVATIONS:

First on-site inspection done since Newcastle Disease prevented on-site inspections. Ranch is now owned by another party other than Hoover. Owner states that there are only approximately 30-40 birds on the ranch and they are free range which requires no manure removal. Manure still remains from cages that have been unoccupied since last October. Only one large leak was present at the time of inspection. No larvae were noted near leak. Several flies were noted at the end of three (3) of the unoccupied coops. There is overgrown and dead vegetation in and around the entire property which is being monitored and will be abated by SB County Land Use Services Weed Abatement Division.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Immediately repair large leak in line in the first house. Remove ALL manure from under the empty cages and dispose of properly (arrange for a pick up-no stockpiling). Abate ALL of the overgrown and vegetation from the property including in or near the empty chicken houses.

ACTION TAKEN:

Will re-inspect on Monday, July 6, 2020 for compliance. If not in compliance fines will be administered.
