OBSERVATIONS:

Fania flies were observed only in the first coop (moderate). Moderate amount of larger flies were noted in the coop with the dirt floor. Many sites (under coops and large pile) were inspected for evidence of larvae.

In the one coop with the dirt floor, compacted manure was inspected in several damp sections and a high concentration of active larvae was noted in all of them. All coops were sprayed with insecticide in the morning, August 14, 2018. Insecticide spraying also occurred Tuesday, August 7, 2018, Thursday, August 9, 2018, and Saturday, August 11, 2018, of last week. Poultry ranch owner was instructed to apply Triazicide granules to the all damp areas last time and failed to do so but was instructed to purchase some TODAY and apply immediately. Fly traps were rejuvenated today, August 14, 2018, and were functioning properly.

There were only a couple of leaks noted including a broken cup that will be replaced today. All broken eggs and feathers that were to be abated between coops and in free range area by today were not done. Minimal dead chicken parts were discovered during the inspection and were immediately removed for disposal.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Maintain removal of chicken manure per the Manure Management Plan requirements (logs sent to City every Monday).
- Disturb compacted manure/dirt mix under dirt coop where larvae were discovered and spray liberally with insecticide along with applying Triazicide to any damp areas **TODAY**.
- Clean up broken eggs and feathers between coops and in the free range chicken enclosure **BEFORE** next inspection.

ACTION TAKEN:

Next on-site inspection scheduled for **Tuesday, August 21, 2018**. A \$200 fine will be issued for non-compliance.
