### OBSERVATIONS:

Fania flies were minimal again. Many sites (under coops) were inspected for evidence of larvae.

In coop #4 (with the dirt floor), compacted manure was inspected in a couple of the damp sections and only in one small area was larvae observed. All coops were treated with insecticide (spray) on Monday, September 24th, Thursday, September 27th, 2018, and Friday, September 28th, 2018 (Triazicide) of last week. Fly traps were rejuvenated on Tuesday, September 25th, 2018.

There were many leaks in both the cups and in some of the water lines (in coop #1) that still need to be repaired.

Feathers and broken eggs were noted between the coops and in free range area that need be abated again. Chickens are still molting. Minimal chicken parts were discovered during the inspection. Several dead chickens were observed and removed immediately.

### RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Maintain removal of chicken manure per the Manure Management Plan requirements (logs sent to City every Monday).
- Repair all leaks in the water lines and in the cups.
- Clean up excessive spilled feed under all of the coops.
- Clear broken eggs and feathers from the free-range coop.

Next on-site inspection scheduled for **Tuesday, October 9, 2018.**
